3D PRINTER POLICY

The Community Library Network offers cardholders the ability to print threedimensional plastic items on our 3D printers using a design uploaded from a digital computer file.

When using our service, please be aware that:

- 1. Only filament supplied by the library can be used.
- 2. Cost for the print will be assessed per each gram of filament. You will know how much the project is going to cost before it is submitted.
- 3. You can only use the 3D printer for lawful purposes. A print will be refused if the object would:
 - a. Be prohibited by local, state or federal law
 - b. Be construed as having intent or capability to harm a person or animal
 - c. Infringe upon the intellectual property rights of a third party
 - d. Be larger than 10" x 6" x 6.7"
- 4. Only one print job may be in the queue at a time. A print job may include more than one object.
- 5. All completed items must be paid in full. We will not reprint a project at no-cost because you are unhappy with the color, quality, design, or other options you pre-selected.
- 6. We can hold your printed items for two weeks. Items not picked up will become property of the library.
- 7. We reserve the right to refuse or deny any 3D printing request.
- 8. By submitting objects for printing, you assume responsibility for all matters related to patented, trademarked, or copyrighted materials.
